### Cascade Dialogues resume Thursday

Land development in Kittitas County, a subject of intense interest, will again be the subject on Thursday when the Cascade Dialogues resume at noon at the Hal Holmes Center in Ellensburg.

The dialogues, which are being sponsored by the Cascade Land Conservancy in four counties, are a public discourse focusing on future growth and development. Where is growth most desirable? How will it affect roads, services, and recreational access? What are conservation priorities? The dialogues explore whether public consensus can be found on these and other issues, and will culminate in a report called the Cascade Agenda, which will summarize what is learned.

Part one of the dialogues, an open debate and discussion, took place on May 6. Part two will examine the comments and suggestions gathered at that meeting, and include a panel discussion with representatives from business, real estate and the media.

Public comment will again be solicited.
